



## Privacy Policy

## **Web privacy policy**

This privacy policy aims to describe the way this website is managed with regard to the processing of the personal data of the users that consult it.

This policy provides the information required pursuant to section 13 of Italian Legislative Decree 19603 (Italian Privacy Act) to those who visit A-Tono's corporate website at <http://www.a-tono.com>

This information is provided only for the website mentioned above and does not apply to other websites which the user may consult through links on the above website.

The [www.a-tono.com](http://www.a-tono.com) website is owned and operated by A-Tono S.r.l., which ensures compliance with the law regarding the protection of personal data (Italian Legislative Decree 19603). Users are required to read this privacy policy carefully before submitting any personal information or completing any form on this website.

### **1) Type of data processed and purpose of the processing**

The browsing data, computer systems and software procedures used to operate this website acquire some personal data during normal operation, which are implicitly transmitted in the use of internet communication protocols. By its nature, this information could be used to identify users by association and processing with data held by third parties, such as your IP address, domain names of computers used by the users who connect to the website, etc. These data are only used for statistical purposes (therefore anonymously) and to make sure the site is operating correctly, and are deleted immediately after processing. Data concerning web contacts are not stored for more than seven days in any case. With the exception of data acquired during computer crimes committed against the website, no data stemming from the web service will be communicated or disseminated.

### **2) Data voluntarily provided by website users. If users connect to this website and send their personal information in order to access certain services or to make requests by email, A-Tono will acquire the sender's email address and possibly other personal data which it will processed only in order to respond to your requests or to provide the service requested.**

The personal information provided by users will be communicated to third parties only if disclosure is necessary in order to comply with requests from the users themselves.

**3) Cookies**

We do not use cookies to transmit personal information, nor are persistent cookies of any kind used, i.e. systems for tracing users. The use of session cookies (which are not permanently stored on the user's system and deleted when the browser is closed) is strictly limited to the transmission of the session identification number (a random number generated by the server) needed to allow sure, efficient site navigation.

The session cookies used by this website make it unnecessary to use other techniques which are potentially prejudicial for the browsing confidentiality of users, and do not allow the acquisition of personal identification data.

**4) Processing methods**

Processing takes place using automated equipment (e.g. electronic procedures and media) or manually (e.g. on hard copies) for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data were collected and in compliance with the laws governing the voluntary provision of data, with the exception of what was stated regarding browsing data.

Users are free to provide their personal data. Failure to provide these data may lead at most to the impossibility of obtaining what they ask for.

**5) Data controller, supervisors and categories of processors**

The data controller is A-Tono S.r.l., with registered office in C.so Buenos Aires 77 - 20124 Milan, Italy. Your data will be processed within the company by the employees of the Corporate and Domestic market offices. These people work as data processors under the direct authority of their respective supervisors.

**6) Rights of interested parties**

Lastly, we would like to remind you that in order to exercise your rights under section 7 of Italian Legislative Decree 196/03 - including the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data, the communication of such data in an intelligible form, to be informed of the source, to obtain updating or erasure of data processed unlawfully, and to object, on legitimate grounds, to their use, you should contact the data privacy manager at the data controller's office or send an email to A-Tono's privacy email address.

You may request a complete list of the individuals in charge of processing your personal data in the same way.
